From 08.00 to 14.00 Participants arrive at Barcelona El Prat International Airport and Sants Train Station.

For those participants arriving at El Prat International Airport, there will be a person of the Costa Barcelona Week organizing team waiting for you in front of Catalonia Tourist Office (right hand side when leaving the terminal). We will be holding a panel with the logo of Costa Barcelona Week.

There will be a shuttle bus from El Prat International Airport to Vilanova i la Geltrú, city where you spend the first day of the trip, during all the morning. When arriving at Vilanova i la Geltrú, check-in at the hotel. Up to 15.00h, free time.

For those participants arriving at Sants Train Station, there will be a person of the Costa Barcelona Week organizing team waiting for you at AVE exit. We will be holding a panel with the logo of Costa Barcelona Week. You will also have a transfer to Vilanova i la Geltrú.

When arriving at Vilanova i la Geltrú, check-in at the hotel. Up to 15.00h, free time.

15.00–16.30 Guided visit to Vilanova i la Geltrú.

10.00-12.00 Guided tour of the fields owned by Fragàncies del Montseny wellness products and visit to Circ Cric.

Montseny Natural Park

Universal heritage. The Montseny Biosphere Reserve is a mosaic of Mediterranean and Central European landscapes located close to major metropolitan conurbations.

13.00 Lunch.

14.30 Transfer to the Maresme Region.

Maresme is a privileged area. It has a long coastline with more than 20,000 protected hectares, included in the Montnegre i Corredor Natural Park, the Coastal Range and the Serra de la Marina. More than 800 plant species and nearly 220 species of vertebrates make it an area of great natural wealth and biodiversity.

15.15–16.45 Cycling activity around the Parc del Montnegre i el Corredor.

The Montnegre and El Corredor massifs form part of the Littoral mountain range and are two mountainous areas parallel to the Mediterranean coast. Both create a natural barrier between the littoral plain of the Maresme and the depression of the regions of El Vallès and La Selva.

16.45 Transfer to Arenys de Munt and activities in the Bosc Vertical Adventure Park.

Enjoy an afternoon of action and adventure.

18.30 Transfer to Santa Susanna and check-in at Casa Rural Can Rosich.

17th May

08.45 Transfer to the starting point of our route.

10.00–12.30 Outdoor activity around La Mola mountain.

La Mola

La Mola is the highest mountain in the Natural Park of Sant Llorenç del Munt i l'Obac (1104 m above sea level). This Natural Park is located between the regions of Bages, Vallès Occidental and Vallès Oriental.

14.30 Transfer to Penedès wine region.

Penedès wine region With its sunlight and proximity to the Mediterranean Sea, the Penedès is a privileged territory for winegrowing. In this incomparable setting, enjoying the sun in the vineyards, strolling around its vi-
